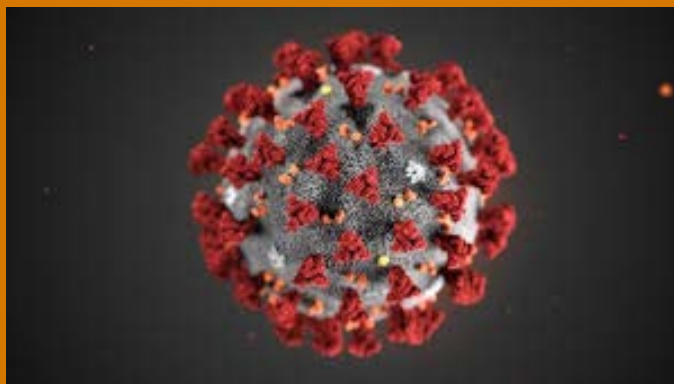

Resident Vaccinations – February 4, 2021

380 vaccinations were given - mostly 2nd dose

- Only a few people who received the vaccination experienced mild symptoms
 - Reports of low-grade fever
 - Body aches
- There were thoughts of a few residents having moderate/severe symptoms; however, after medical evaluation it was determined the symptoms were unrelated to the vaccination.

- Everyone who wishes to participate in 2/18 clinic must complete a Walgreens consent form
- If you haven't yet received a vaccine and want to, residents should pick up a consent form from The Clinic.
- OPPs
 - Forms have been sent out to OPPs via text platform to print out, can be picked up from Tisha Crawford or in The Clinic
 - Please turn your forms in directly to Tisha Crawford or can be left in the Clinic in the **basket labeled "OPPs"**
- **Deadline to turn in consent forms is Friday, February 12th**



Vaccine FYIs



Lenbrook

- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT remove any COVID-19 best practices.
 - Experts say, “Currently, we do not have enough data to be able to say with confidence that the vaccines can prevent transmission. So even if vaccinated, you may still be able to spread the virus to vulnerable people.”
 - Therefore, mask usage is still important – reduces risk of potential spread
- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT void any isolation or quarantines.
- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT make you exempt from transmitting the virus to those who are not vaccinated.
- CDC cites there is not enough data on how long immunity lasts after vaccination. CDC will continue to update as more information is known.



Vaccine FYIs

- The CDC recommends if you have already had COVID-19 and recovered, you should still be vaccinated.
- If you have received another type of vaccination, such as the flu or shingles, it is advised that you wait at least 14 days before getting the COVID-19 vaccination.

Stepped Re-Opening Plan

- Using current info and current metrics – this is the very next step for Independent Living
 - HC and AL have to abide by federal regs and dept of community health
- Advance, pause, assess
- Continue to create a pathway to advance or regress
- Trigger to advance – two-week trend of declining:
 - **Internal metrics**
 - External metrics, and
 - 90%+ of our IL population 7 days post 2nd vaccine clinic
- Targeting March 1, 2021 - "The March Plan"

Philosophy

Begin to restore some elements of **community living** while maintaining **infectious disease best practices** - on campus and off



Guidelines

- Continuing to wear a mask when outside of your residence or office
- Always distancing (6 feet)
- # of people gathering in shared space driven by 6-foot distancing, with max 25 people in a shared space

Examples



Lenbrook

- Exercise classes – 10 people
 - Assess demand and adjust
- Friends of the Arts (similar programs / events) with audience of no more than 25
- Excursions to locations who have adopted best practices
- Committee / group meetings



Dining



Lenbrook

- All venues reopening
- Details being worked out now and will be communicated prior to March 1 opening
- Reduced capacity
- One table grouping distanced six feet from another table grouping
- Four top tables



What else...

- From your vehicle, card or fob to permit you to exit
- Like salon stylists, massage therapists, reflexologists, Vicki the seamstress back on site – all with increased personal protective equipment

What you can expect to see...

- Over next two weeks, departments working on details to pivot
- Will update you as details unfold
- Watch K4, digital signage, Spotlight

What about.....



Lenbrook

- Can I gather in my neighbor's apartment?
 - Distance
 - Time
 - No more than four people as long as you can distance



What about...

- Visitation

- In the first step of reopening we will focus on restoring outdoor visitation
- We will create a pathway for inside visitation as we work toward the next phase of reopening plan.
 - Advance, pause, assess
