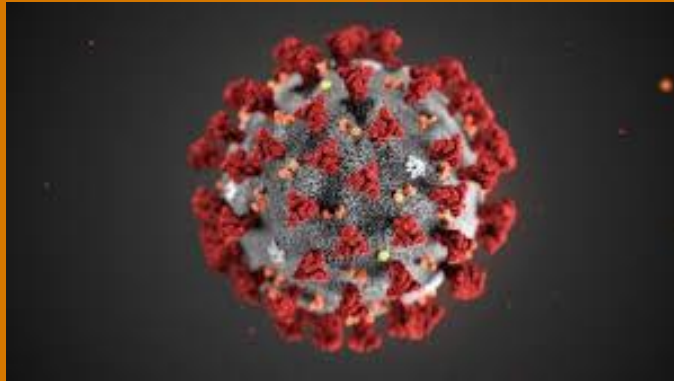

*** THIS IS A SECOND DOSE CLINIC ONLY***

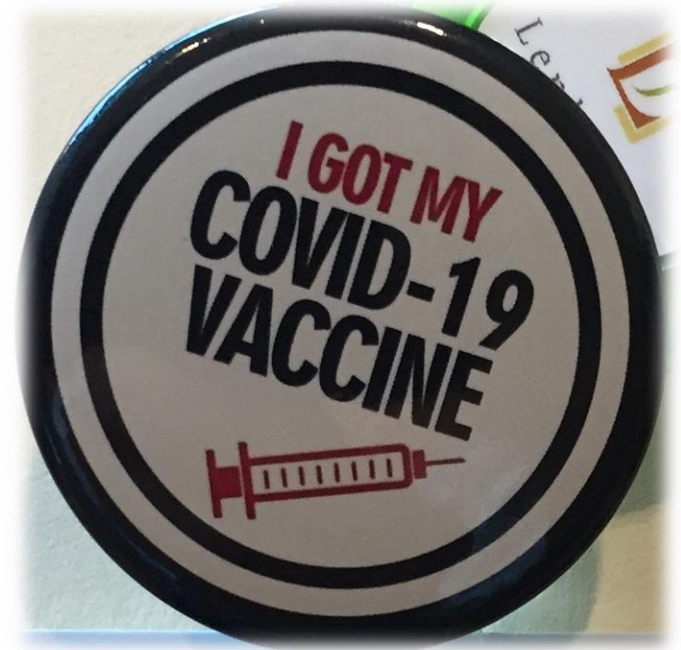
- This will be our last scheduled clinic; however, the VP of Health Services is working on securing future clinics

General Guidance

Lenbrook's Health Care and Assisted Living Centers will be scheduling outside visitation as follows:

- Monday thru Friday with 10am being our first available slot and 4pm being the last available slot.
- Residents who are on isolation protocol for COVID-19 infection, new admission observation or COVID-19 exposure will not be able to participate in visitation until they have completed their required quarantine or isolation.

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Stepped Re-Opening Plan



Lenbrook

- Using current info and current metrics – this is the very next step for Independent Living
 - HC and AL have to abide by federal regs and dept of community health
- Advance, pause, assess
- Continue to create a pathway to advance or regress
- Trigger to advance – two-week trend of declining:
 - **Internal metrics**
 - External metrics, and
 - 90%+ of our IL population 7 days post 2nd vaccine clinic
- Targeting March 1, 2021 - "The March Plan"

Guidelines



Lenbrook

- Continuing to wear a mask when outside of your residence or office (except when eating or drinking)
- Always distancing (6 feet)
- # of people gathering in shared space driven by 6-foot distancing, with max 25 people in a shared space

 - Overnight stays are permitted in residence

 - Catering / Room Service options
 - Not our forever plan – our right now plan
 - Advance, pause, assess

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Communication



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- Always check Digital Signage and the K4 app for the latest updates for new programs, events and excursions



Guidelines we will use when planning programs, events, excursions

- Six-foot physical distancing and max room capacity of 25
- Mask usage when not eating or drinking
- Hand sanitizing and hand washing
- Any off-campus excursion destinations observe the same COVID best practices

Safety

- All participants must wear a mask.
- All participants will get temperature checks.
- All will adhere to social distancing (six feet apart)
- Ten people is the max for the fitness center and classes. Four for pool attendance
- All must use the sanitizing wipes after using equipment.
- Showering permitted effective March 1st.

COVID-19 Guidelines for fitness classes

- Our aerobics room is set up to accommodate 10 people with social distancing.
- All class participants and instructors wear a mask at all times.
- Call Lynette at ext. 2216 or Charles at ext. 2425 to schedule your reservation for the fitness center and/or exercise class

Restart of fitness classes

- March 1-12 three classes per week
- March 15-26 five classes per week
- March 29 fully ramped up
- Toward end of month we will have Beverly and Cherri teaching

- All classes for the first month will be modified to slowly increase strength and endurance which may have declined while classes were paused.

- All fitness classes will be instructed by Lynette and Charles.

- Dinner will be from 5:00 pm - 8:00pm
- Tables will be socially distanced so not full capacity (about half of normal)



Reopening March 1st

- Two-week Dinner test with no reservations
- Will be full at 6:00 pm so arrive early or arrive late!
- Will evaluate and make decision mid-March on reservation policy



Special Note about Room Service:

- Room Service will continue with no delivery fees for now
- Process remains unchanged
 - Menus for tomorrow are delivered by 9 am today
 - Tomorrow's order to be placed outside your door by 8 am



Special Note about Room Service:

- Menu will be a variation of The Brook menu for Lunch and The Grill menu for Dinner
- If missing something, please call the Brook at extension 2035 and we will run it right up!

- Open Monday to Saturday
- Monday and Tuesday will be Chop House menu
- Wednesday to Saturday will be Fine Dining menu

- Reservations required call 2035, no more than 7 days in advance
- Tables will be distanced so not full capacity (about half of normal)
- Private Dining Room will be available for Fine Dining Meals or private events of 8 or less



C-Store Operations

- Starting March 1st, we will allow two people in at a time for in person shopping
- Please sanitize hands upon entering space

Visitors and Guests

- At this time, we are not yet opening venues to visitors and guests
- Room service or The Brook take out is available if you dine in your residence with your guest





Special Note about Gift Cards:

- Gift Cards that expired in December, January, and February will be extended to expire on March 31st, 2021
- Please see a Dining Manager to make that adjustment. Servers can not adjust the cards
