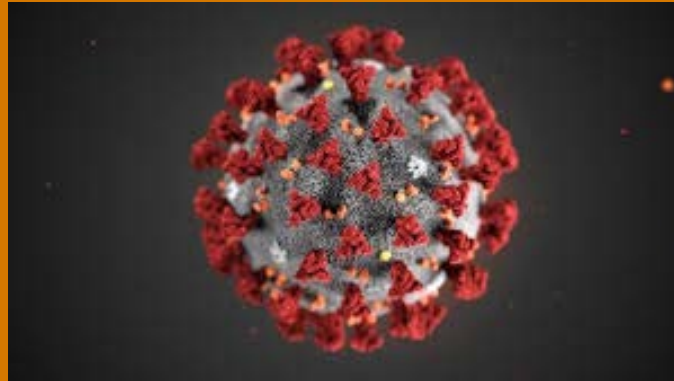

Vaccination Update

Resident Vaccinations

Of those 9% Independent Living residents who did not participate in Lenbrook's vaccination events:

~7 residents received the vaccine outside of Lenbrook

~5 residents were excluded for medical reasons or actively COVID+

~11 residents were recovering from recent COVID+ infection

~12 residents (for their own personal reason) did not participate

Vaccination Time: 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

***** THIS IS A SECOND DOSE CLINIC*****

- Everyone who is registered will be assigned an appointment window
- If you are registered, you should have received a bright colored sheet of paper under your door with instructions and times
- Do not show up earlier than your beginning window time

- Medical Insurance Card (insurance is not required but bring card if covered)

General Guidance for February 4, 2021

What to Expect:

- We will be queuing participants in holding areas so everyone can maintain 6' distance - ***Do not congregate where you cannot socially distance.***
- All participants must complete a temperature check and a screening questionnaire.
- All participants will be monitored by clinical staff for ~15 minutes after receiving the vaccine. Please plan accordingly and be patient.



Vaccine FYIs



Lenbrook

- To accept the vaccination, you must be free of any COVID-19 symptoms
- If you are under quarantine due to a confirmed exposure with a positive COVID-19 person at the time of the vaccination, this is a disqualification for receiving the vaccination
- If you have been released from a 14-day COVID-19 isolation period, you could possibly receive the vaccination*

***NOTE: If you have received any specialized treatment while being seen in the hospital/ER for COVID-19, you may be disqualified from receiving the vaccination. The Clinic will notify you if you have been disqualified.**



Vaccine FYIs



Lenbrook

- To reduce pain and discomfort where you got the shot:
 - Apply a clean, cool, wet washcloth over the area.
 - Use or exercise your arm.
 - Talk to your doctor about taking an over-the-counter medicine, such as ibuprofen or acetaminophen pre- or post-vaccination.



Vaccine FYIs



Lenbrook

- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT remove any COVID-19 best practices.
- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT void any isolation or quarantines.
- Receiving the vaccination DOES NOT make you exempt from transmitting the virus to those who are not vaccinated.
- CDC cites there is not enough data on how long immunity lasts after vaccination. CDC will continue to update as more information is known.



Vaccine FYIs



Lenbrook

- The CDC recommends if you have already had COVID-19 and recovered, you should still be vaccinated.
- Even after the second vaccination, the CDC recommends wearing masks and practicing social distancing. Experts need to understand more about the protection that COVID-19 vaccines provide in real-world conditions before making that decision. It is not yet known whether getting a COVID-19 vaccine will prevent you from spreading the virus to other people. CDC will continue to update as more information is known.
- If you have received another type of vaccination, such as the flu or shingles, it is advised that you wait at least 14 days before getting the COVID-19 vaccination.

Question and Answer



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Question and Answer

- Q. Do I need to wear a mask when I am **OUTSIDE?**
- A. CDC guidance says
 - Stay at least 6 feet from people you don't live with (“social distancing”) at all times.
 - Wear a mask as feasible. Masks are **most** essential in times when social distancing is difficult
 - **Our recommendation is:**
 - **If you are alone, ok to not wear a mask**
 - **When in presence of others outside your household wear a mask**



Q. What percentage of Lenbrook residents and associates have been fully or partially immunized, or are scheduled to be immunized? I think it might be interesting to know the degree of vaccine acceptability of the Lenbrook community. I ask this question in the light of several news reports that vaccine acceptability among workers in long-term care facilities is less than optimal.

A. Our clinics to date have only partially immunized (first doses only to date). See slide 10 and 12 for participation rates.

- Urgency was around vaccinating those most at risk, the vaccine protects the individual from severe outcomes
- Will continue to education and encourage all under our roof to be vaccinated



- Q. Please address whether or not you will get a manicurist back in the salon in light of the fact that it is better to do it here than to go out into the community to get those services.
- A. If you are interested in a manicure or pedicure, our existing stylists are credentialed to provide nail services. We will be able to schedule a nail service in an available open slot. Also, PS Salon does have a position posted for a nail tech so we can have someone dedicated to providing these services.



Q. I had leftover flex funds and purchased a dining gift card which expired at the end of December. What can we do about that?





- A. Dining gift card expiration dates that are set to expire in December, January and February will now expire 30 days from when dining venues re-open. The re-open date is not yet set. Please see or call a dining manager to make this adjustment once venues re-open.
