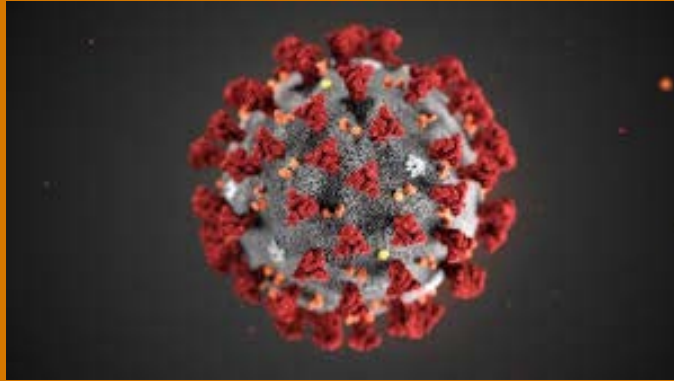

Participation Percentages

71% of residents & associates have been vaccinated

4% of associates have immunity through illness

75% of Lenbrook's residents and associates (combined) have achieved immunity

Vaccine Updates

What does vaccination participation mean:

- Focusing on vaccination participation is the light at the end of the tunnel to prevent tragic loss and severe illness.
- However, focusing on best practices is the **only method to keep transmission down**. Little is known on how variants will be impacted by the vaccine.
- Focusing on the theory of herd immunity only works if our community never interacted with external community.
- Through contact tracing, at a high level, we have identified the majority of our COVID-19 cases were contracted through resident-to-resident contact, behind OPP-to-resident contact.

Vaccine Updates

Since Lenbrook's vaccination clinics

- One resident who received both doses of the vaccination tested positive
 - Positive COVID test was completed 12 days post vaccination
 - Exposure from non-COVID-19 hospital visit
 - Remains asymptomatic
- One associate who received both doses of the vaccination tested positive
 - Test was completed 8 days post vaccination
 - Exposure from off campus contact
 - Experiencing mild symptoms

Vaccine Updates

According to the New England Journal of Medicine:

- It may take up to a few weeks for someone to achieve full effectiveness of the vaccine, depending on the individual
- The Pfizer vaccine showed to be 52% effective at preventing COVID-19 illness after the 1st dose
- The Pfizer vaccine showed to be 95% effective at preventing COVID-19 illness after the 2nd dose and at least 7 days post vaccination

Vaccine Updates



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Walgreens shared the following:

- Vaccinated people could have contracted COVID-19 at a point before their vaccine reached its peak effectiveness, as the incubation period for this virus can be up to 14 days before symptoms appear.
- Some patients who contract COVID-19 **might not experience any symptoms but remain contagious.**
- **It is also still possible for patients who are fully vaccinated to become infected with COVID-19,** but the severity of the illness may be less than it would have been had the individual not been vaccinated.



Best Practices



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- Lenbrook's COVID-19 Taskforce has no data to support any theories of these positive cases
- If you are with those outside of your household (those you are with 24/7) make sure:
 - You and they always wear a mask – Over the nose and under the chin
 - Stay six feet apart
 - Limit time of exposure
- Common areas require wearing a mask and maintain social distance.
 - Common areas are for less than 15 minutes of socialization
 - As Lenbrook re-opens - KNOW YOUR RISKS.

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Stepped Re-Opening Plan

- Using current info and current metrics – this is the very next step for Independent Living
 - HC and AL have to abide by federal regs and dept of community health
- Advance, pause, assess
- Continue to create a pathway to advance or regress
- Trigger to advance – two-week trend of declining:
 - **Internal metrics**
 - External metrics, and
 - 90%+ of our IL population 7 days post 2nd vaccine clinic
- Targeting March 1, 2021 - "The March Plan"

Guidelines



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- Continuing to wear a mask when outside of your residence or office (except when eating or drinking)
- Always distancing (6 feet)
- # of people gathering in shared space driven by 6-foot distancing, with max 25 people in a shared space

Visitation
