Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing.

What this means for you

Fully vaccinated means 2 weeks after your 2nd dose for a two-dose vaccine or 2 weeks after a single dose vaccine

Vaccines are effective but risks still exist.

Please consult your doctor about how this guidance applies to you.



What this means for Lenbrook

Fully vaccinated residents and guests may discontinue use of masks and physical distancing if in Independent Living areas.

Mask usage is still required for everyone in Healthcare and Assisted Living.

We're relying on residents to determine vaccination status of their guests, and to enforce mask usage as required.

It is still a Lenbrook policy that all Staff must wear a mask and maintain physical distancing.



Please Continue to Wear a Mask If...

You are NOT fully vaccinated

You are symptomatic (Please report symptoms to the Clinic.)

Your doctor advises.

You are Staff (associates, contractors, OPPs, volunteers, etc.)



Right to Privacy

You'll continue to see mask usage throughout the community.

Please respect those who continue to wear a mask as it is a personal and private matter.
